# SUDs in Small Developments Project

- Royal Haskoning consultants hired August 2011
- Funded by RBKC and Thames Water
- Tool to determine the volume of storage and the potential SUDS
- Will aid the implementation of CE2
- Output: simple database with drop down boxes to ensure consistency
- Tool will be in the website to include SUDs in the design stage
- We aim to start using the tool early next year



# Community Flood Plans CFP

- Previous discussions and meeting in September (Drain London, SN team members, Planning and Contingency Planning)
- A pilot will start in Holland Ward
- A CFP brings together the community to understand flood risk, locations that might flood, the reasons, and actions to reduce potential severity of the flood and any associated damage and distress
- Dialogue on flooding with organisations – potentially strengthening the voice of the community on flood issues
- The EA will provide the CFP template and some funding
- The pilot project was discussed at the ward panel meeting in November

- Description of the flooding issues
- Strategy/solutions:
  - reduction of water run-off,
  - disconnection to sewer,
  - reduction of impermeable surfaces
  - increase of Counters Creek Capacity
- Explanation of our new duties as a LLFA
