Statement of Significant Change: 2018-19 Charges Schemes

In accordance with Ofwat Information notice (IN 17/09 December 2017) "Statement of any significant change in charges" and section A2 of the Annex to the Charges scheme rules issued by Ofwat in December 2016, we make the following statements:

- (a) The Board has reviewed the effects of the 2018-19 charges on customers' bills for a wide range of different customer types and is not aware of any bill increases that exceed 5%.
- (b) There are no significant changes in charging policy from the previous year for charges made to our customers.

For developer charges that are subject to our Charges Schemes, significant changes have been made to Infrastructure Charges so as to comply with the Charging Rules for New Connection Services issued by Ofwat in August 2017. Although reducing our Infrastructure Charges, this has not materially impacted the overall balance of charges recovered from developers and customers because Infrastructure Charges make up only one element of the overall developer charges included within the wholesale revenue price controls.
